

Tavern Policies

Tabs

Tabs are beneficial to players as they allow players to get food without having to carry real world money around. We are happy to offer that option to our players, and we are establishing these rules so that everyone will be on the same page.

To establish a tab requires an initial deposit of \$20. You can always cash out the balance of your tab at the end of the event, or you can let the balance ride to the next event.

Once an account is established, we will advance it up to \$15 in credit. If an account ends an event in the negative, it will need to be brought up to a zero balance at the start of the next event.

Only spouses or children may share a tab. You can buy something for someone else on your tab, but they cannot ask that an item be billed to your tab in your absence.

NPCs

We depend on our NPCs and need them to stay fed and hydrated. NPCs eat both breakfasts and Saturday's dinner in the tavern for free, but need to get snacks and lunch in Monstertown. All of that is covered in their \$10 event fee. If they want something else from the tavern, they will need to purchase it themselves. They should either put on a white headband and enter the kitchen through the back door, or they should ask a CC member about appropriate characters to play when going into the tavern. We request that the NPCs not eat in the dining area out-of-play. If NPCs are going into the kitchen to eat, we ask that they hang out by the back door.

Menu

Saturday night's feast will be announced before the event. If someone doesn't want to eat that, then they can order off the regular menu, but we ask that they be patient with the preparation of their special order. There will be a posted menu with regular prices that will include sandwiches, drinks, fruit, and a variety of snacks. If you have special dietary restrictions, please let us know before the event and we will see what we can do to accommodate you.

Hours

The kitchen will be open for most of the event. It will close late Friday and Saturday nights depending on business and availability of staff. We will begin serving breakfast at 8am Central on Saturday and Sunday. The kitchen will close at 4pm Central on Saturday so that the staff can do dinner prep. Dinner will be served at 7pm Central.

Bringing Your Own Food

If you don't want our food for whatever reason, that's totally cool. We have ample refrigerator space at this site and can store your food. We ask two things though. First, let us know when you pre-register so that we don't plan for you. Secondly, please wait until after we have finished meal prep for Saturday's dinner before you come into the kitchen to make your food.
